HAPPY EASTER


Dear friends, the feast of Easter is celebrating Jesus' victory over death and mankind's hope for eternal life. This feast gives us the new hope of our own Resurrection at the end of times and at the same time keeps us one with the living Christ who will be always with us. This year the Feast of Easter is celebrated differently unlike previous years due to Covid19 pandemic. There will be no Blessing of fire and procession with people in attendance, no Baptisms during Easter Vigil and the list goes on. Nevertheless, that doesn't stop us from celebrating the fundamental truth of Christ Resurrection. The theme of today's Mass includes both proclamation and witness. St Paul tells us that if Jesus is not risen from the dead, our faith will be in vain. In the Gospel, Mary Magdalene is asked to go and proclaim the Resurrection to all. 


