EUCHARISTIC MEAL

Dear friends, in the Gospel of today Matthew assumes the reader to be familiar with the remarkable story of Elisha where he feeds a mere one hundred people with only twenty barley loaves. There it seemed impossible to feed so many people with so little bread. But after people were fed, they too had collected

the fragments left over. Therefore, the action of Jesus appears even more astounding, given the few loaves and the immense crowds needing to be fed. Again, not only are the people fed but there are twelve baskets of leftovers. Here we notice that there is no attempt to describe what Jesus actually did or how he fed so many with so little. Any and all speculations on that is a waste of time. What God did in the desert to feed the hungry Israelites with Manna in desert, same Jesus did here to feed the large crowd in a deserted place. Jesus just cared for those in need and looked after the hungry people who came looking for the divine meal. The miracle of the multiplication of loaves tells how God really cares for those people in abundance in time of their need. It also tells us about the future events to come when Jesus will provide his people with the Eucharistic meal. Here Jesus looks up to heaven, blesses the bread and gives to his disciples who in turn feed the crowds. These came to be known as the **Eucharistic gestures. There is even greater** reference to the great messianic banquet that Jesus will ultimately preside over at the end of time.
