FAITH IN ACTION

Dear friends, today's readings are highly relevant to our own lives. On the one hand, we live in a world where thousands suffer in the struggle for truth, freedom and dignity of the human person. On the other hand, we live in a world of ever-increasing material indulgence becoming available to more and more people. The dream of being part of this can close our minds and hearts to the cry of the poor, distressed and marginalized. The affluent society becomes both a trap and an escape. Many like to blame God for many of the world's problems but, to be honest, they are practically all of our own making. In the Gospel the plea is to increase their faith that they may see. Jesus teaches them that they do not need an increase in faith so much as they need to put the little faith they have into action. Paul in the second reading tells Timothy to teach his community to use the precious gifts the Lord gave to serve by being courageously at the service of all who are in need. We must be aware that God's gift is not a spirit of timidity, but the Spirit of power, and love, and self-control. The first reading calls for fidelity to God in the midst of suffering and violence that people have experienced. The future belongs to God's faithful people.
