CARE FOR CREATION

Formaldehyde occurs naturally in the environment, but it is also found in a broad range of consumer products such as pressed wood, textiles and even cosmetics. Formaldehyde has been classified as a **probable human carcinogen**. Exposure to formaldehyde used in **wrinkle-free fabrics** may cause contact dermatitis in some individuals. **Ask** about the formaldehyde content of pressed wood products for use in your home. Good ventilation, moderate temperatures and controlled humidity help to reduce formaldehyde levels. **Wash all permanent-pressed clothing and linens before using.**
